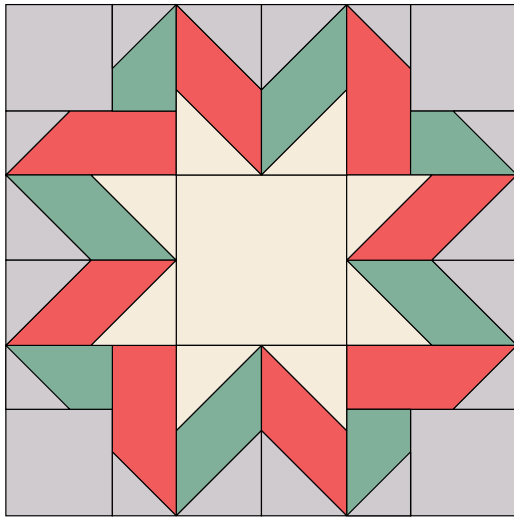
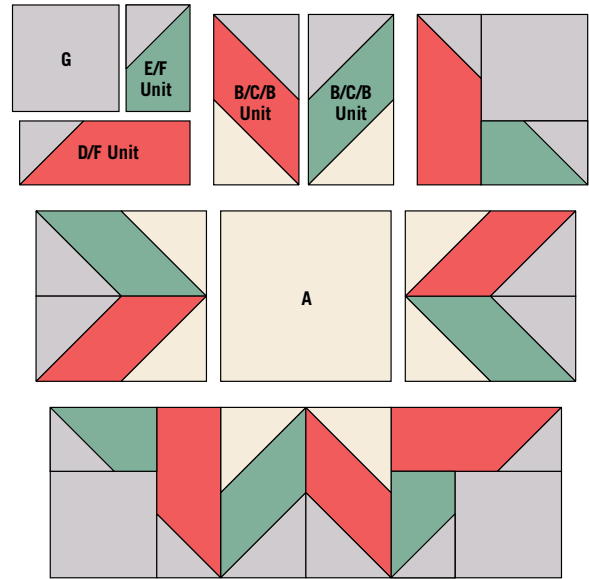

**Christmas Star Piecing**

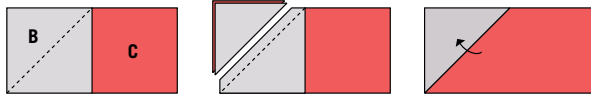
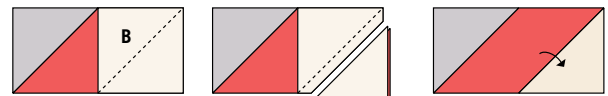

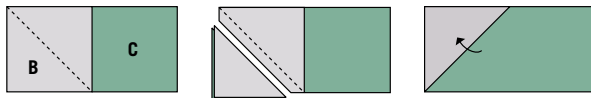
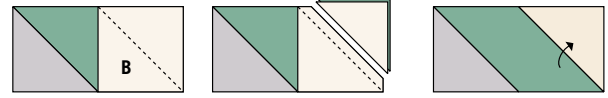

Make 4

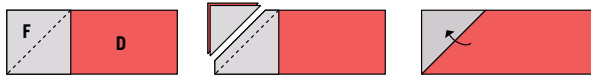

Make 4

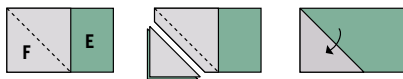

## Fabric and cutting requirements for each Christmas Star block

White	8" x 12" scrap	1 A, 8 B
Red	6" x 19" scrap	4 C, 4 D
Green	6" x 19" scrap	4 C, 4 E
Silver	10" x 15" scrap	8 B, 8 F, 4 G

## Patches

A = 4½" square	E = 2" x 3" rectangle
B = 2½" square	F = 2" square
C = 2½" x 4½" rectangle	G = 3" square
D = 2" x 4½" rectangle	

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the silver B's. Referring to Fig. 1, align a silver B with a red C as shown and stitch along the drawn line. Trim ¼" outside the stitched line. Press the B open. Repeat to join a white B to each unit. Make 4. In the same manner, join the remaining white and silver B's to the green C's as shown in Fig. 2. Referring to the block piecing diagram, join pairs of red and green units, matching seams.

In the same manner, join the silver F's to the red D's as shown in Fig. 3, and the silver F's to the green E's as shown in Fig. 4. Referring to the block piecing diagram, join one E/F unit to a G, and then join that to a D/F unit to create a corner unit. Repeat to make four corner units.

Referring to the block piecing diagram, join the units into rows. Join the rows. **TQL**
