

BLOCK 1

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

- (4) 1½" x 2½"
- (8) 11/2" x 11/2"

From the coral fabric, cut:

- (4) 11/2" x 21/2"
- (4) 11/2" x 11/2"

From the yellow fabric, cut:


(1) 2½" x 2½"

From the green fabric, cut:

(4) 1½" x 1½"

FOUR PATCH UNITS


Arrange a coral, a green, and 2 white 1½" squares as shown below. Sew together in pairs and press. Then sew the pairs together.



Four Patch unit measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 4.

RAIL UNITS

Arrange a coral and a white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle as shown below. Sew together on the long side.




Rail unit measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 4.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows.

Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
