BLOCK 2

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

- (2) 21/2" x 21/2"
- (8) 2" x 2"

From the coral fabric, cut:

(2) 2" x 3½"

From the yellow fabric, cut:


(2) 2" x 3½"

From the green fabric, cut:

(2) 2½" x 2½"

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of the white $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a green $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, right sides together. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to 2" square.



Make 4 white/green HST.


CORNER FLIP UNITS

Mark the wrong side of a white 2" square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a yellow 2" x 3½" rectangle on the left end, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Make 2 yellow/white Corner Flip units.




CORNER FLIP UNITS (CONTINUED)

Repeat to make 2 coral/white Corner Flip units as shown below.



BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
