BLOCK 3

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

- (2) 3" x 3"
- (4) 1½" x 1½"

From the coral fabric, cut:

- (2) 3" x 3"

From the yellow fabric, cut:

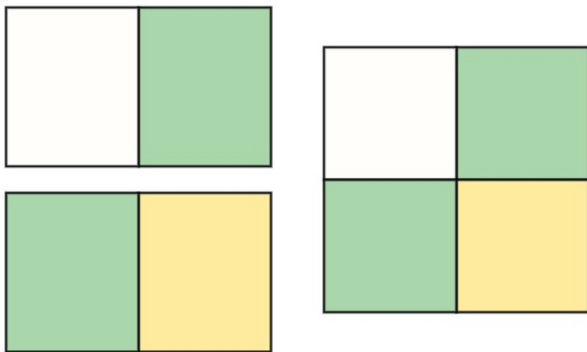
- (1) 2½" x 2½"
- (4) 1½" x 1½"

From the green fabric, cut:

- (8) 1½" x 1½"

FOUR PATCH UNITS

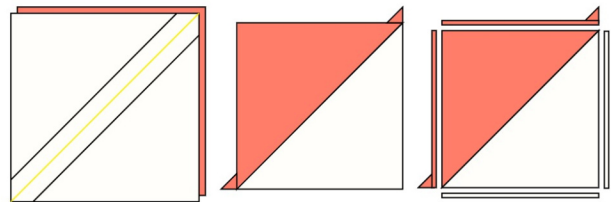
Arrange a white, a yellow, and 2 green 1½" squares as shown below. Sew together in pairs and press. Then sew the pairs together.



Four Patch unit measures 2½" x 2½" unfinished.
Make 4.

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS

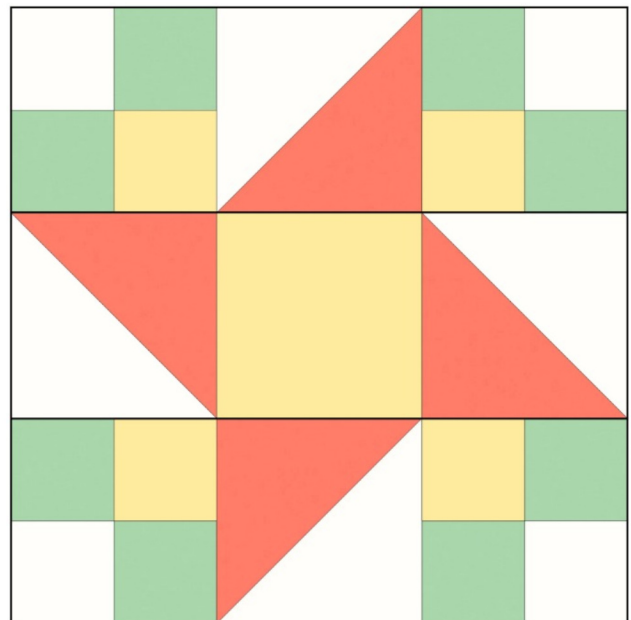
Mark the wrong side of the white 3" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a coral 3" square, right sides together. Sew a ¼" from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to 2½" square.



Make 4 white/coral HST.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 6½" x 6½" unfinished.
