

BLOCK 3

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

(2) 3" x 3"

(4) 1½" x 1½"

From the coral fabric, cut:

(2) 3" x 3"

From the yellow fabric, cut:

(1) 2½" x 2½"


(4) 1½" x 1½"

From the green fabric, cut:

(8) 1½" x 1½"

FOUR PATCH UNITS


Arrange a white, a yellow, and 2 green 1½" squares as shown below. Sew together in pairs and press. Then sew the pairs together.



Four Patch unit measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 4.

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of the white 3" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a coral 3" square, right sides together. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to $\frac{2}{2}$ " square.




Make 4 white/coral HST.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows.

Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
