## BLOCK 5

### CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:  
(4)  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$

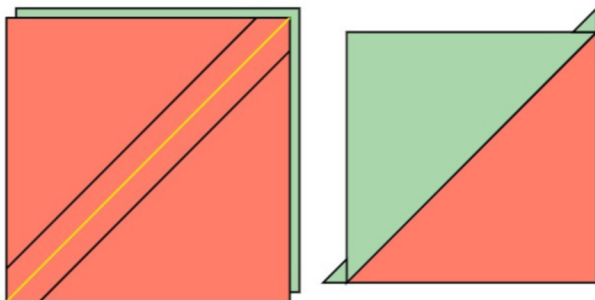
From the coral fabric, cut:  
(1)  $3\frac{3}{8}'' \times 3\frac{3}{8}''$

From the yellow fabric, cut:  
(4)  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$

From the green fabric, cut:  
(1)  $3\frac{3}{8}'' \times 3\frac{3}{8}''$

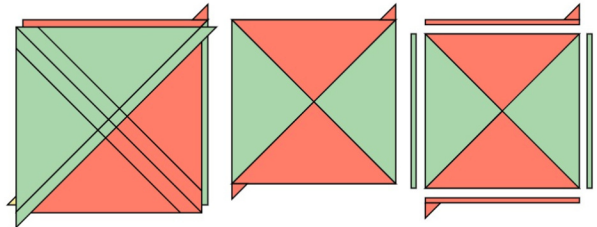
### QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLE (QST) UNIT

Mark the wrong side of the coral  $3\frac{3}{8}''$  square in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a green  $3\frac{3}{8}''$  square, right sides together. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}''$  from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line and press to make 2 HST.



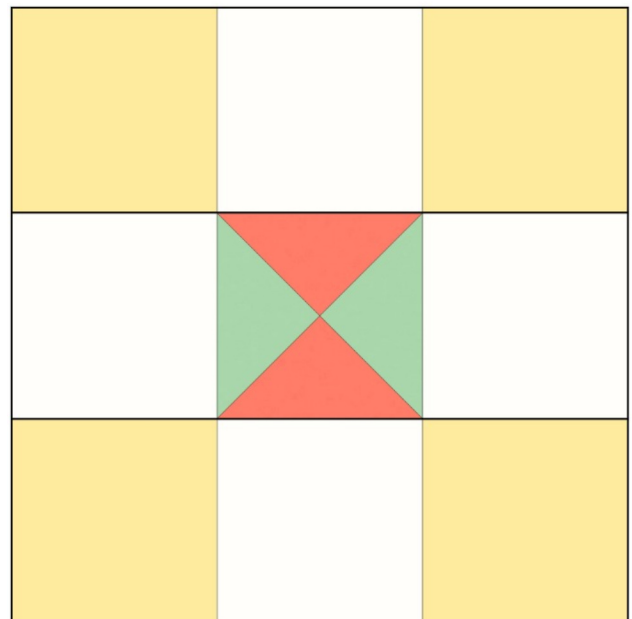
### QST UNIT (CONTINUED)

Take the HST from the previous step. Mark the wrong side of one of the HST in half diagonally once. Lay the marked HST over the other HST with opposite colors facing each other. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}''$  from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line to make 2 coral/green QST. Only one QST is needed, so discard the extra. Trim QST unit to  $2\frac{1}{2}''$  square.



### BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures  $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  unfinished.
