

BLOCK 8

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut: (4) 1½" x 2½"


From the coral fabric, cut: $(4) 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the yellow fabric, cut: (5) 2½" x 2½"

From the green fabric, cut: (8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ "

FLYING GEESE UNITS


Mark the wrong side of a green $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a coral $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and press. Repeat on the other side with another marked green $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



Make 4 coral/green Flying Geese units.


RAIL PATCH UNITS

Arrange a Flying Geese unit and a white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle as shown below and sew together. Rail Patch unit measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 4.



BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
