

BLOCK 9

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

(4) 2" x 31/2"

(6) 2" x 2"

From the coral fabric, cut:

(4) 2" x 31/2"

From the yellow fabric, cut:


(6) 2" x 2"

From the green fabric, cut:

(4) 2" x 2"

FLYING GEESE UNITS


Mark the wrong side of a green 2" square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a white 2" x 3½" rectangle, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the other side with another marked yellow 2" square.



Make 4 Flying Geese units.


CORNER FLIP UNITS

Mark the wrong side of a white 2" square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a coral 2" x 3½" rectangle on the left end, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the opposite corner with a white 2" square.



Make 2 coral/white Corner Flip units.

Repeat with a yellow 2" square, a white 2" square, and a coral 2" x 3½" rectangle as shown below.




Make 2 coral/yellow/white Corner Flip units.



BLOCK 9

QUARTER SECTION UNITS


Arrange a Flying Geese unit and a Corner Flip unit as shown below and sew together. Quarter Section unit measures 3½" x 3½" unfinished.



Make 4 Quarter Section units.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
