## BLOCK 10

### CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

- (2) 3" x 3"
- (2) 2½" x 4½"

From the coral fabric, cut:

- (1) 2½" x 2½"

From the yellow fabric, cut:

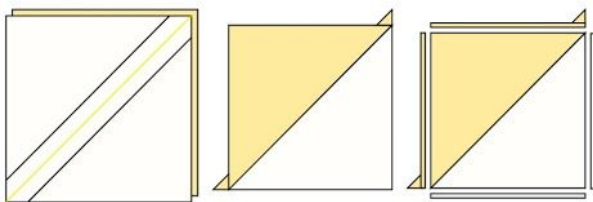
- (1) 3" x 3"
- (2) 2½" x 2½"

From the green fabric, cut:

- (1) 3" x 3"
- (2) 2½" x 2½"

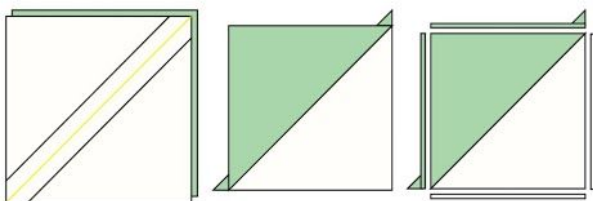
### HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of the white 3" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a yellow 3" square, right sides together. Sew a ¼" from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to 2½" square.



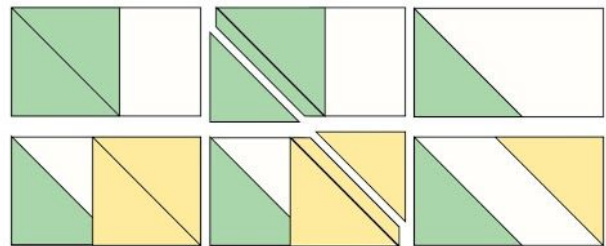
Make 2 white/yellow HST.

Repeat to make 2 white/green HST.



### CORNER FLIP UNITS

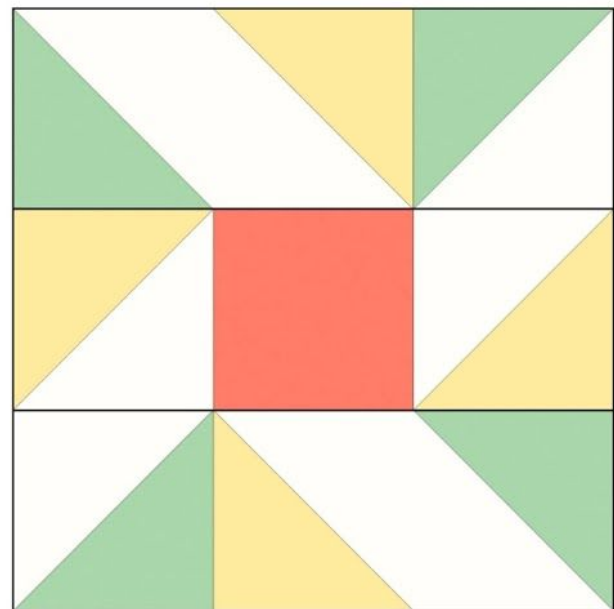
Mark the wrong side of a green 2½" square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a white 2½" x 4½" rectangle on the left end, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the opposite corner with a yellow 2½" square.



Make 2 Corner Flip units.

### BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 6½" x 6½" unfinished.
