## **BLOCK 13**

#### CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

(2) 3" x 3"

(4) 11/2" x 21/2"

From the coral fabric, cut:

(2) 3" x 3"

From the yellow fabric, cut:


(1) 21/2" x 21/2"

From the green fabric, cut:

(8) 1" x 21/2"

#### **RAIL UNITS**


Arrange two green 1" x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and a white  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle as shown below. Sew together on the long sides.



Rail unit measures  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 4.

### HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS


Mark the wrong side of the white 3" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a coral 3" square, right sides together. Sew a 1/4" from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to 21/2" square.



Make 4 white/coral HST.

#### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
