BLOCK 17

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:
(4) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$

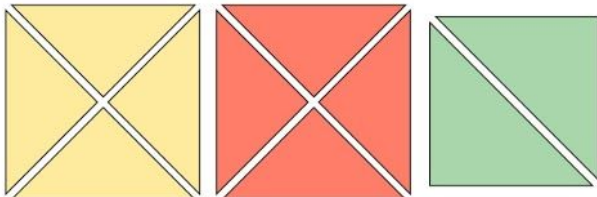
From the coral fabric, cut:
(1) $3\frac{3}{8}'' \times 3\frac{3}{8}''$
(1) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$

From the yellow fabric, cut:
(1) $3\frac{3}{8}'' \times 3\frac{3}{8}''$

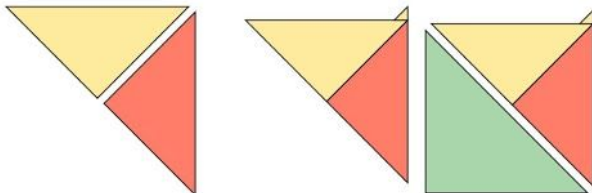
From the green fabric, cut:
(2) $3'' \times 3''$

SPLIT QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLE (SPLIT QST) UNITS

Cut a yellow and a coral $3\frac{3}{8}''$ square in half diagonally twice. Cut both green $3''$ squares in half once.

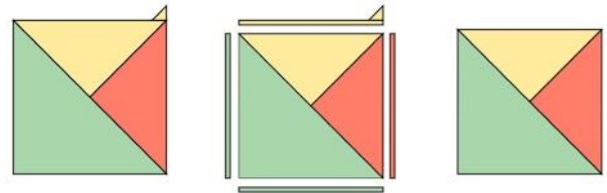


Sew a yellow and coral quarter square triangle together as shown below and press. Then sew a green half square triangle to the pair.



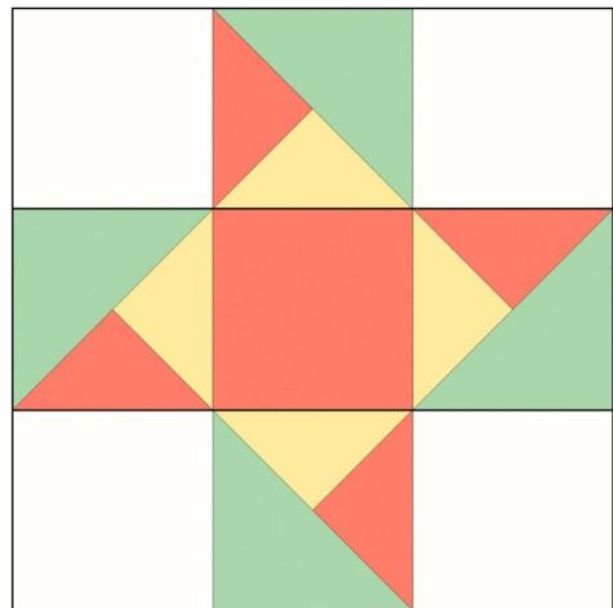
SPLIT QST UNITS (CONTINUED)

Trim the Split QST evenly to $2\frac{1}{2}''$ square. Repeat to make 4 Split QST units.



BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ unfinished.
