

BLOCK 21

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut: (12) 2" x 2"


From the coral fabric, cut: $(4) 2'' \times 3^{1/2}''$

From the yellow fabric, cut: (4) 2" x 2"


From the green fabric, cut: $(4) 2'' \times 3^{1/2}''$

CORNER FLIP UNITS

Mark the wrong side of a yellow 2" square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a coral 2" x 3½" rectangle on the right end, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the opposite corner with a white 2" square. Make 4 coral/white/yellow Corner Flip units.




Repeat with two white squares and a green rectangle as shown below. Make 4 green/white Corner Flip units.



QUARTER SECTION UNITS


Arrange one of each of the Corner Flip units as shown below and sew together.



Quarter Section unit measures $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 4.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
