

BLOCK 22

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut: $(4) 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the coral fabric, cut: (1) 33% x 33%


From the yellow fabric, cut:

- (1) 33/8" x 33/8"
- (1) 21/2" x 21/2"


From the green fabric, cut: (2) 3%" x 3%"

QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLE (QST) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of a coral 3%" square in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a green 3%" square, right sides together. Sew ¼" from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line and press to make 2 coral/green HST.




Repeat with a green and yellow 33/8" square to make 2 green/yellow HST.



QST UNITS (CONTINUED)


Take the HST from the previous steps. Mark the wrong side of one of the HST in half diagonally once. Lay the marked HST over the other HST with opposite colors facing each other. Sew ¼" from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line.



Trim QST unit to 21/2" square. Make 4.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
