

BLOCK 23

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

- (4) 2" x 31/2"
- (4) 2" x 2"

From the coral fabric, cut:

(2) 2½" x 2½"

From the yellow fabric, cut:

(2) 21/2" x 21/2"

From the green fabric, cut:


(8) 2" x 2"

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of the coral $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a yellow $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, right sides together. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to 2" square.







Make 4 coral/yellow HST.


PINWHEEL UNIT

Arrange the 4 coral/yellow HST into a Pinwheel as shown below. Sew together in pairs and press, then sew the pairs together. Pinwheel unit measures $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 1.



FLYING GEESE UNITS


Mark the wrong side of a green 2" square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a white 2" x 3½" rectangle, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the other side with another marked green 2" square.



Make 4 white/green Flying Geese units.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
