BLOCK 30

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut: (8) 2" x 2"

From the yellow fabric, cut:

(4) 2" x 31/2"


(4) 2" x 2"

From the green fabric, cut:

(4) 2" x 2"

FLYING GEESE UNITS


Mark the wrong side of a green 2" square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a yellow 2" x 3½" rectangle, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the other side with another marked white 2" square.



Make 4 yellow/green/white Flying Geese units.


QUARTER SECTION UNITS

Arrange a yellow and a white 2" square, and a Flying Geese unit as shown below. Sew the squares together and press. Sew the Flying Geese unit to the pair. Quarter Section unit measures $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 4.



BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
