

BLOCK 31

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut: (4) 2" x 2"

From the coral fabric, cut: $(4) 2'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$


From the yellow fabric, cut:

- (1) 31/2" x 31/2"
- (2) 21/2" x 21/2"
- (8) 2" x 2"

From the green fabric, cut: (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "


HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of the green $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a yellow $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, right sides together. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to 2" square. Make 4 green/yellow HST.



SQUARE IN A SQUARE (SIAS) UNIT


Mark 4 white 2" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over the corner of a yellow 3½" square. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the remaining corners to make an SIAS unit. Make 1.



FLYING GEESE UNITS


Mark the wrong side of two yellow 2" square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square with a coral 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and press. Repeat on the other side with another yellow 2" square.

Make 4 coral/yellow Flying Geese units.



BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
