BLOCK 32

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

- (2) 3" x 3"
- (4) 11/2" x 21/2"

From the coral fabric, cut:

(1) 21/2" x 21/2"

From the yellow fabric, cut:


(2) 3" x 3"

From the green fabric, cut:

(4) 11/2" x 21/2"

RAIL UNITS


Arrange a green and a white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle as shown below. Sew together on the long side.



Rail unit measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 4.

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS


Mark the wrong side of the white 3" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a yellow 3" square, right sides together. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to $\frac{2}{2}$ " square.



Make 4 white/yellow HST.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
