BLOCK 34

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:
(4) 2½" x 2½"

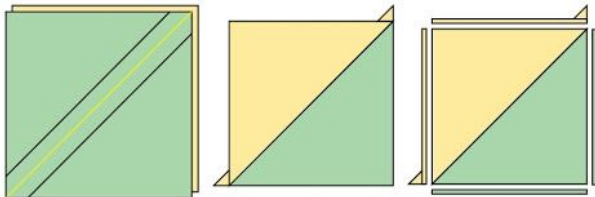
From the coral fabric, cut:
(8) 1½" x 1½"

From the yellow fabric, cut:
(2) 3" x 3"
(1) 2½" x 2½"

From the green fabric, cut:
(2) 3" x 3"

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS

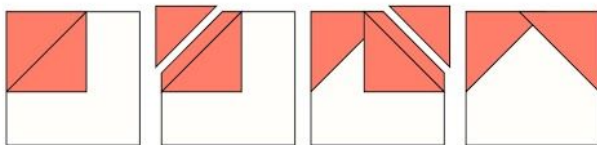
Mark the wrong side of the green 3" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a yellow 3" square, right sides together. Sew a ¼" from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to 2½" square.



Make 4 green/yellow HST.

STAR POINT UNITS

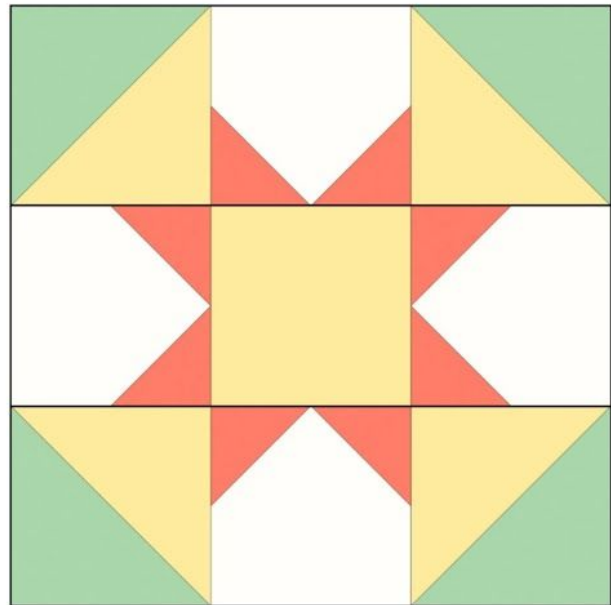
Mark the wrong side of the coral 1½" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square right sides together with a white 2½" square, as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the other side with another marked coral 1½" square.



Make 4 Star Point units.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 6½" x 6½" unfinished.
