

## BLOCK 35

## CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut: (10) 2" x 2"


From the coral fabric, cut: (2) 2" x 2"

From the yellow fabric, cut:  $(4) 3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "


From the green fabric, cut: (4) 2" x 2"

## SQUARE IN A SQUARE (SIAS) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of 2 white, 1 coral and 1 green 2" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over the corner of a yellow 3½" square, right sides together as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the remaining corners with the remaining marked squares to make a yellow/white/coral/green SIAS unit. Make 2.




Repeat with 1 green and 3 white 2" squares and a yellow  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square as shown below. Make 2.



## **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
