## LARGE BLOOM BLOCK

#### CUTTING


From the white fabric, cut: (60) 33/8" x 33/8" (120) 3" x 3" (60) 21/2" x 61/2" (240) 11/2" x 11/2"

From the coral fabric, cut: (60) 3% x 3%

From the yellow fabric, cut:  $(120) 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "


#### YELLOW PETAL UNITS

Mark the wrong side of a white 1½" square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a yellow 2½" square, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the other side with another marked white 1½" square. Make 120 Yellow Petal units.




# SPLIT QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLE (SPLIT QST) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of the white 33/8" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a coral 33/8" square, right sides together. Sew a 1/4" from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Make 120 white/coral HST.



#### SPLIT QST UNITS (CONTINUED)


Mark the wrong side of the white 3" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a white/coral HST from the previous step, right sides together. Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to  $\frac{2}{2}$ " square.



Make 240 white/coral Split QST. Note that half will appear with the coral on top and half with the coral on bottom.

#### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished. Make 60.

## **BLOOM BORDER BLOCK**

#### CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

- (12) 33/8" x 33/8"
- (24) 3" x 3"
- (48) 11/2" x 11/2"


From the coral fabric, cut:  $(12) 3\frac{3}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{3}{8}$ "

From the yellow fabric, cut: (24) 2½" x 2½"

#### YELLOW PETAL UNITS

Mark the wrong side of a white  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a yellow  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and press.


Repeat on the other side with another marked white  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



Make 24 Yellow Petal units.


## SPLIT QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLE (SPLIT QST) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of the white 33%" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a coral 33%" square, right sides together. Sew a 14" from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Make 24 white/coral HST.



#### SPLIT QST UNITS (CONTINUED)


Mark the wrong side of the white 3" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a white/coral HST from the previous step, right sides together. Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



Make 48 white/coral Split QST. Note that half will appear with the coral on top and half with the coral on bottom.

#### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces together to complete the block.



Block measures 21/2" x 61/2" unfinished. Make 24.

### SMALL BLOOM BLOCK

#### CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut: (50) 2" x 2" (400) 11/2" x 11/2"


From the coral fabric, cut: (100) 2½" x 2½" (100) 1½" x 1½"

From the yellow fabric, cut: (25) 2½" x 2½"

From the green fabric, cut: (50) 2" x 2" (100) 1½" x 2½"


#### HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of the white 2" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a green 2" square, right sides together. Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make 100 white/green HST.



#### CORNER FLIP UNITS


Mark the wrong side of a white  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a green  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle on the left end, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and press.



Make 100 green/white Corner Flip units.

#### **LEAF UNITS**

Arrange a white/green HST, a white  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square and a green/white Corner Flip unit as shown below. Sew the HST and square together and press. Then sew the Corner Flip unit to the pair.




Leaf unit measures  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 100 Leaf units.

#### CORAL PETAL UNITS

Mark the wrong side of a white  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a coral  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and press.

Repeat on the other side with another marked white  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



Make 100 Coral Petal units.




# SMALL BLOOM BLOCK

#### SQUARE IN A SQUARE (SIAS) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of 4 coral  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over the corner of a yellow  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, right sides together. Sew on the marked line.


Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the remaining corners with the marked squares to make an SIAS unit.



Make 25 SIAS units.

#### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew the units into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished. Make 25.

## LEAF BORDER BLOCK

#### CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:


- (20) 21/2" x 21/2"
- (22) 2" x 2"
- (88) 11/2" x 11/2"

From the green fabric, cut:

- (22) 2" x 2"
- (44) 11/2" x 21/2"

#### HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS


Mark the wrong side of the white 2" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a green 2" square, right sides together. Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



Make 44 white/green HST.

#### **CORNER FLIP UNITS**


Mark the wrong side of a white  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a green  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle on the left end, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and press.



Make 44 green/white Corner Flip units.

#### **LEAF UNITS**

Arrange a white/green HST, a white  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square, and a green/white Corner Flip unit as shown below. Sew the HST and square together and press. Then sew the Corner Flip unit to the pair.



Make 44 Leaf units.
Set 4 aside for Leaf Border Corner blocks.

#### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces together to complete the block.



Block measures  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 20 Leaf Border Blocks.
