## BLOCK 24

### CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

- (1)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{3}{8}$ "
- (4) 3" x 3"

From the coral fabric, cut:

- (1)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{3}{8}$ "

From the yellow fabric, cut:

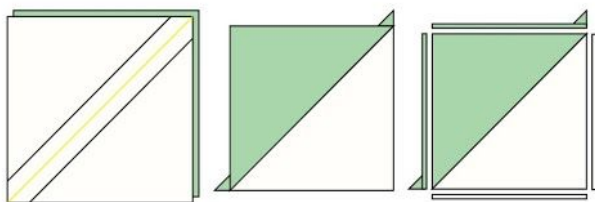
- (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the green fabric, cut:

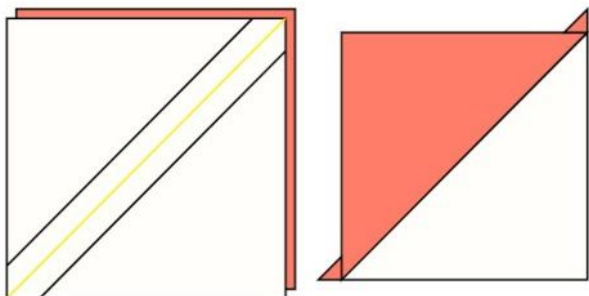
- (2) 3" x 3"

### HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of the white 3" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a green 3" square, right sides together. Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make 4 white/green HST.

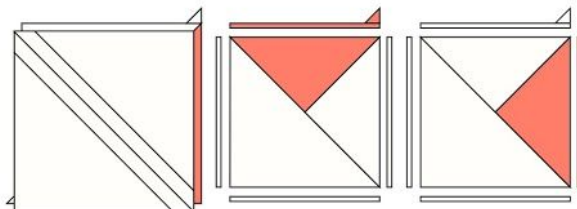


Repeat with the white and coral  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares to make 2 white/coral HST, but leave untrimmed.



### SPLIT QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLE (SPLIT QST) UNITS

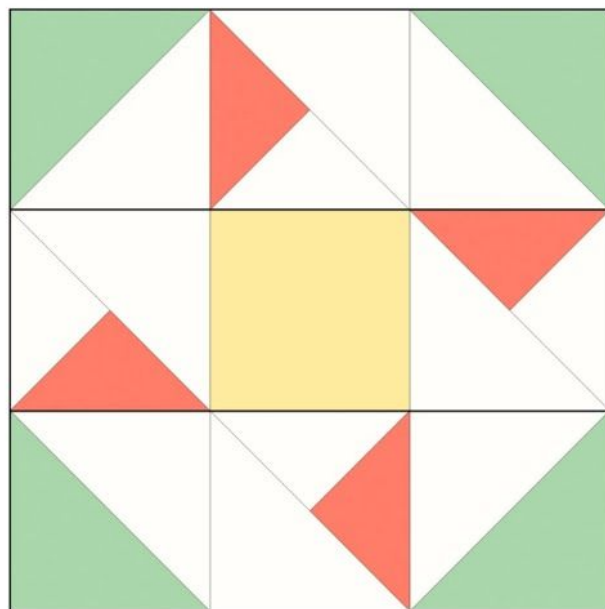
Mark the wrong side of the white 3" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a white/coral HST from the previous step, right sides together. Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



Make 4 white/coral Split QST. Note that half will appear with the coral on top and half with the coral on bottom.

### BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
