### **BLOCK 24**

#### CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

- (1) 33/8" x 33/8"
- (4) 3" x 3"

From the coral fabric, cut:

(1) 33/8" x 33/8"

From the yellow fabric, cut:


(1) 21/2" x 21/2"

From the green fabric, cut:


(2) 3" x 3"

#### HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of the white 3" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a green 3" square, right sides together. Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to  $\frac{2}{2}$ " square. Make 4 white/green HST.




Repeat with the white and coral 3%" squares to make 2 white/coral HST, but leave untrimmed.



## SPLIT QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLE (SPLIT QST) UNITS


Mark the wrong side of the white 3" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a white/coral HST from the previous step, right sides together. Sew a ¼" from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to 2 ½" square.



Make 4 white/coral Split QST. Note that half will appear with the coral on top and half with the coral on bottom.

#### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
