BLOCK 25

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

- (4) 11/2" x 21/2"
- (8) 11/2" x 11/2"

From the coral fabric, cut:

(5) 21/2" x 21/2"

From the yellow fabric, cut:


(4) 11/2" x 21/2"

From the green fabric, cut:

(8) 11/2" x 11/2"


HALF SNOWBALL UNITS

Mark the wrong side of two white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a coral $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Sew on the marked line. Trim a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and press. Repeat on the diagonally opposite corner. Make 4.




FLYING GEESE UNITS

Mark the wrong side of a green $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square on a white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and press. Repeat on the other side with another marked green $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make 4 white/green Flying Geese units.



STAR POINT UNITS


Arrange a Flying Geese unit and a yellow $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle as shown below. Sew together and press.



Star Point unit measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 4.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
