

BLOCK 29

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut: (4) 3" x 3"

From the coral fabric, cut: (2) 3" x 3"

From the yellow fabric, cut:


- (2) 3" x 3"
- (1) 21/2" x 21/2"

From the green fabric, cut:


(4) 11/2" x 11/2"

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of the white 3" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a coral 3" square, right sides together. Sew a 1/4" from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to 21/2" square. Make 4 white/coral HST.




Repeat to make 4 white/yellow HST.




SQUARE IN A SQUARE (SIAS) UNIT

Mark the wrong side of 4 green 1½" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over the corner of a yellow 2½" square, right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the remaining corners with the marked squares to make an SIAS unit. Make 1.



BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
